Quinn... Charles Quinn is a foreman at the railroad's engine house at the south end of Central Street. Charles is boarding at 3 Beech Street, at the home of Samuel E. Bailey, just around the corner from the engine house. (1929-31)

Quirk ... Edmund F. Quirk is an assistant at St. Joseph's Church on Pine Street. He is living on Pine Street in 1915. In 1919 Edmund is listed as removing to Dover, NH.
