Yeaton ... Walter J. Yeaton is a ticket agent for the Boston & Maine Railroad. Walter is rooming in the Sargent Block, at 35 Central Street. (1915-1925) Walter and Elizabeth Yeaton removed to Benton, NH, prior to 1935.

Yikopulos ... George N. Yakopoulis was a cook at Teh=gu'e Cafe and had his own diner just passed the railraid trestle in Wells River. George N. Yakopoulis 1892-1973

*** Arthur W. Young is a carpenter. Arthur and Leona A. Young have a house on Highland Street. (1915)

*** Carl M. Young is a fireman on the railroad, boarding at 9 Perkins Place, the home of Foster C. Turner. (1925) Carl and Frances P. Young removed to White River Jct., Vermont, prior to 1936.

*** Edward F. Young is manager of Hovey's Shops on Central Street, the old Sargent Store. Ed also manages the rental rooms upstairs, which he turned into apartments. Before then the rooms were rented, mostly by the day, to railroad men laying over. Ed was residing in Lyndon, Vermont at the time. His previous employment was with Goss Tire Company, in St. Johnsbury. Vermont. (1956 - 1958)

*** Homer Young is a woodsman, residing at 26 Connecticut Street. (1956 - 1958)

*** Mrs. Katheryn P. Young is a cook at the Grafton County Farm, where she is boarding. (1935 - 1937)

*** Lionel F. Young is employed in Lisbon, NH. Lionel boards at 26 Connecticut Street, the home of Mrs. Phoebe H. Langford. (1953 - 1955)

*** Morris R. Young is a farmhand at A. A. Irwin's and he boards there, at RFD #2. (1919)

*** Nedd Young is an employee at the Grafton County Farm, where he and Laura are boarding. (1935 - 1937)
